#### **Review Process**

#### **Submission Guidelines**

Manuscripts should be sent to the Editor at the Editorial Address for submission procedure. The manuscript should be accompanied by a covering letter stating that the article has not been published, or submitted for publication, elsewhere. Authors are asked to submit three copies of their manuscript as wel as an identical electronic copy on computer disk, typed in Word (or RTF) format. Short titles are invited for use as running heads. The author should submit a short biography of him or herself and a 50-80 words abstract along with three keywords both in English and French.
